## Brush Drop-off Program Resumes May 14

The Village's Public Works Department and the Park District operate a brush chipping site on 71st Street just west of Woodridge Drive. The Brush Drop-off Program is held on the 2nd Saturday of the month May through October from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Cars dropping off materials will be charged \$5 for the first car load and an additional \$3 for each return trip made that day. Trucks, vans, or trailers will pay \$10.00 for each load dropped off that day. The Village site does not require bundling, has no length requirement, and can accept branches up to 5" in diameter. Proof of residency is required. The chips generated by this program will be made available to residents for free pick-up at the mulch pile on Woodridge Drive.

## Large Recycling Event – May 14th

The annual Recycling Extravaganza will take place on Saturday, May 14, from 8:00 a.m. until noon at Cypress Cove Family Aquatic Park – located at 8301 Janes Avenue in Woodridge.

Brought to you by the Woodridge Rotary Club, in partnership with many community organizations and Goodwill Industries, the event will collect bicycles (in any condition), household batteries, large batteries with lead in them (car, sump pump, motorcycle), eyeglasses, keys, scrap metal (including swing sets, fencing), household and kitchen items (dishes, silverware, glasses, linens), jewelry, clothing, games, toys, musical instruments, sports equipment, worn American Flags, buttons from clothes, documents to shred (3 boxes or bags per car), ink jet cartridges, and cell phones. No paint, fire extinguishers or CFL bulbs will be accepted. Televisions can be recycled for \$20 each (cash only, no projection TVs). Other electronics, including VCRs, DVD players, computers keyboards, monitors, radios and more can be recycled free of charge. ## Steps to Prevent Loose Recyclables from Littering Our Streets

Individuals can take several steps to prevent recyclables from blowing around during windy spring weather. This includes putting the lighter items such as paper and plastic items on the bottom of the bin with the heavier items on top. These light items can also be placed in paper bags in order to contain them. If you have multiple recycling bins, the bins can be stacked on top of one another, with the lighter items in the bottom bin. Recycle bins are available for sale at Ace Hardware, 8625 Woodward Avenue, for \$8.00 each. As another option, Waste Management (WM) offers recycling totes with lids for rental or purchase. 
