The Woodridge Police Department Reminds Residents of the 30th Anniversary of National Night Out

(Woodridge, IL) – Woodridge Police Department announced on July 22, 2013 that it will be hosting a 30th Anniversary *National Night Out* celebration on Tuesday, August 6th from 4:00pm until 8:00pm at the Community Resource Center (CRC). This event will bring together the community in order to promote a strong and safe village united against crime. Many activities for children will be provided by local businesses and community organizations, including a DJ and inflatable bouncy house. The Woodridge Park District will provide games, and the Police Department will be on duty to give K9 demonstrations. Food and water will be provided by Doggie Diner, Papa's Pizza, Qway's and the Community Resource Center. Qway's will also be offering free haircuts for kids from 4-6pm.

All Woodridge residents are encouraged to attend. The CRC is located at 8274 Janes Avenue in Woodridge, and the festivities will take place in the grassy, common area across from the CRC.

National Night Out is a crime and drug prevention event that is sponsored nationally by the *National Association of Town Watch* and co-sponsored locally by the **Woodridge Police Department**. This year marks the thirtieth anniversary of this event, and over 37 million people across the country are expected to participate.

National Night Out is designed to:

- Heighten crime and drug prevention awareness.
- Generate support for, and participation in, local anti-crime efforts.
- Strengthen neighborhood spirit and police/community partnerships.
- Send a message to criminals letting them know neighborhoods are organized and fighting back.

This year, *National Night Out* and the **Woodridge Police Department** want to notify and encourage citizens to sign up for Smart911, a free service that allows citizens across the U.S. to create a Safety Profile for their household that includes any information they want 9-1-1 to have in the event of an emergency.
