

DuPage County Tax Code Comparison



Taxing Body Comparison

This document includes a comparison of the Woodridge Taxing Bodies to their counterparts within DuPage County for the 2010 tax levy year. The Village of Woodridge is a Home Rule municipality. Non Home Rule municipalities are required to stay within a tax cap. Over the past 24 year the Village Board has focused on reducing the municipal tax rate each year and staying within the non-home rule tax cap voluntarily in order to keep municipal taxes low for Village residents. This policy allows Woodridge to remain in the lowest quartile of the DuPage community tax rates in 2010 with its ranking at 6th lowest of the 35 communities.

The current Woodridge tax rate of **0.2568** is **49%** of the average municipal tax rate of **0.5294**. When looking at the decreases in Woodridge's tax rate since 1990, the rate of change is one of the highest in the County.

Exemptions for Senior Citizens

There are three (3) real estate tax exemptions that may be available to senior citizens .

- 1) Senior Citizens' Homestead Exemption provides for a maximum of a \$4,000 reduction in the equalized assessed valuation.
- 2) Senior Citizens' Assessment Freeze Homestead Exemption provides seniors with limited income, protection against real estate taxes due to rising property values (not tax rates).
- 3) Senior Citizens' Real Estate Tax Deferral Program allows seniors with limited income and who meet other qualifications to defer payment of real estate taxes.


